Fall Protection - Competent Supervisor

Tom Hamann will review one of the critical components of a Fall Protection System, the Competent Supervisor. What does *competent supervision for fall protection activities* mean on your worksite?

Protection from falling can be confusing. There are a lot of different products and approaches to reduce the risk of falls on our worksites. Workers are receiving training, but is it the right training for your fall protection plans? Who is evaluating these risks on the worksite?

Supervisors are taking on more responsibility and are required to be competent. What is a Competent Supervisor for work where there is a risk of falls? What do they need to know to make sure your team is setup for success?
