






Chemical Safety Maze








Safe Bicycle Maintenance



Store chemicals out of reach	Jump one at a time on the trampoline
Place glass or breakable objects out of reach

Move appliances away from sink	
Move objects away from the edge of the counter o	r table
Living Room:	
Place safety covers over unused electrical outlets	
Move heavy or breakable objects away from the ed	lge of tables
Tuck electrical cords behind furniture or media unit	t and away from walking areas
Move candles and matches out of reach	
Bedroom:	
Move electrical cords away from walking areas	
Place toys and other objects back in their designate	ed spots
Bathroom:	
Store chemicals, cleaning supplies and medication	out of reach
Store sharp objects out of reach	
Store all electrical appliances away from the sink or	r tub and in their designated spots
Wipe up spills on the floor	
Unplug all electrical appliances	
Basement:	
Move toys and other objects away from stairs	
Place safety covers over unused electrical outlets	
Use a power bar for a computer
