## **Beyond the Sparks and Flame - Stacey C. Blundell**

This session will focus on a few of the common respiratory hazards associated with welding. Emphasis will be placed on manganese and hexavalent chromium exposures. This session will include a brief regulatory review covering elements pertaining to respiratory protection, a short summary of respiratory protection fundamentals and respiratory protection options for welding fume.
